- **Empower believers to break the cycle of poverty and dependency on unbelievers.** We will teach believers godly principles of prosperity and provide short-term business skills training.

Three Pressing Needs

To launch the evangelistic portion of the ministry, we must

1. Purchase an effective, heavy-duty sound system for the crusades.
2. Purchase reliable transportation for the evangelistic team in Liberia.
3. Renovate the office building rented for LIFEJEM.





History

Joseph and Elisabeth Bimba are indigenous missionary evangelists from Liberia, West Africa. As teenagers, Joseph and Elisabeth were radically saved at Foya Free Pentecostal Church, established by the Swedish Pentecostal Mission, in rural Lofa County. They served the Lord initially as youth leaders; later the Lord called them as missionary evangelists to their own people.

They founded Liberia for Jesus Evangelistic Ministries (LIFEJEM) in 1988. Their ministry focused on serving local pastors and churches struggling in the interior of Liberia, where witchcraft, idolatry, and animism dominated. They conducted small and large crusades in the interior. Thousands were saved, healed, and delivered at these crusades. Villages, public schools, and churches were mightily influenced by the Gospel.

In 1989, civil war broke out in Liberia. Muslims confiscated the Bimbas' house and their ministry equipment and vehicles. Islamic rebels violently targeted Christians in Liberia. To escape these rebels, the couple, with their children (Namie, aged 3, and Elaine, aged 1) on their backs, waded across the low waters of Makona River to neighboring Guinea.

Since arriving in the United States from Guinea in 1993, the Bimbas have been in contact with Liberian refugees scattered in neighboring countries. God has used them to be a blessing to Liberian refugees in Europe, America, and Africa.

In 2006, the Bimbas spent 6 weeks in Liberia. The Lord moved mightily through them: Some of Liberia's new political leaders heard the Gospel; many souls were saved, healed, and delivered; and churches were revived and edified.

In 1997, the Lord led the Bimbas to establish Global Gospel Ministries Inc. (GGMI), a 501c(3) nonprofit, to effectively reach the nations of Africa. Now the Lord is calling the Bimbas back to Liberia—to take the nation for Him, to bring healing and restoration through His Gospel. So Joseph and Elisabeth have quit their jobs, and they, with their four children, are preparing to return to Liberia to fulfill the Lord's call.

Vision for Liberia

GGMI's vision for Liberia is to take Liberia for Jesus at all levels. We will

- **Hold evangelistic crusades.** In partnership with local churches, these crusades will be held all over Liberia—to turn the unsaved from darkness to light, from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Christ (Acts 26:18).
- **Preach in local churches.** In response to requests of local pastors, we will preach in their churches and thereby encourage and motivate their members to win the lost at all cost.
- **Conduct church leadership training.** We will train and equip pastors, evangelists, ministry leaders,
